Governors (Salary and Pensions) Amendment Regulation 2021

Human Rights Certificate

In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, Annastacia Palaszczuk MP, Premier and Minister for the Olympics provide this human rights certificate with respect to the *Governors (Salary and Pensions) Amendment Regulation 2021* made under the *Governors (Salary and Pensions) Act 2003* (the Act).

In my opinion, the *Governors (Salary and Pensions) Amendment Regulation 2021*, as tabled in the Legislative Assembly, is compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

Section 3 of the Act prescribes that a salary is payable to the Governor at the rate prescribed under a regulation.

The Governors (Salary and Pensions) Amendment Regulation 2021 amends the Governors (Salary and Pensions) Regulation 2013 to prescribe the salary rate for the Governor of Queensland, effective from 1 November 2021.

Human Rights Issues

Human rights relevant to the subordinate legislation (Part 2, Division 2 and 3 *Human Rights Act 2019*)

The Governors (Salary and Pensions) Amendment Regulation 2021 does not affect or engage a human right.

Conclusion

I consider that the *Governors (Salary and Pensions) Amendment Regulation 2021* is compatible with the *Human Rights Act 2019* because it does not limit human rights.
