

# Proclamation – Queensland Community Safety Act 2024

## Human Rights Certificate

### Prepared in accordance with Part 3 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*

In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, Dan Purdie, Minister for Police and Emergency Services provide this human rights certificate with respect to the *Proclamation - Queensland Community Safety Act 2024* made under the *Queensland Community Safety Act 2024*.

In my opinion, the Proclamation as tabled in the Legislative Assembly, is compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

### Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

The purpose of the Proclamation is to fix a commencement date of 28 April 2025 for the commencement of the following parts of the *Queensland Community Safety Act 2024*:

- Part 2, division 4, subdivision 3, other than sections 46 to 49 and section 51; and
- Part 3, division 3.

On commencement, these provisions contribute to the overarching objective of the *Queensland Community Safety Act 2024* of optimising and strengthening law enforcement capabilities, improving crime prevention strategies and addressing key issues affecting public security and wellbeing.

### Human Rights Issues

#### Human rights relevant to the subordinate legislation (Part 2, Division 2 and 3 *Human Rights Act 2019*)

The Proclamation does not affect or engage an individual's human rights.

### Conclusion

I consider that the Proclamation is compatible with the *Human Rights Act 2019* because it does not raise a human rights issue.
