In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, Dan Purdie, Minister for Police and Emergency Services provide this human rights certificate with respect to the *Proclamation* - *Queensland Community Safety Act 2024* made under the *Queensland Community Safety Act 2024*.

In my opinion, the Proclamation as tabled in the Legislative Assembly, is compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

The purpose of the Proclamation is to fix a commencement date of 28 April 2025 for the commencement of the following parts of the *Queensland Community Safety Act 2024*:

- Part 2, division 4, subdivision 3, other than sections 46 to 49 and section 51; and
- Part 3, division 3.

On commencement, these provisions contribute to the overarching objective of the *Queensland Community Safety Act 2024* of optimising and strengthening law enforcement capabilities, improving crime prevention strategies and addressing key issues affecting public security and wellbeing.

Human Rights Issues

Human rights relevant to the subordinate legislation (Part 2, Division 2 and 3 *Human Rights Act 2019*)

The Proclamation does not affect or engage an individual's human rights.

Conclusion

I consider that the Proclamation is compatible with the *Human Rights Act 2019* because it does not raise a human rights issue.
