## Part 1 Preliminary

#### 1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Public Health and Other Legislation (Extension of Expiring Provisions) Amendment Act 2021.

#### 2 Commencement

Part 4, division 3 commences on 1 October 2021.

  - (b) expires at the end of the stated period unless the regulation is sooner repealed or it expires under section 324(3).

(1) Section 323(3), as inserted by this Act—

- (3) A regulation extending the period of a declared public health emergency expires 14 days after the public health emergency is declared unless it is sooner repealed or it expires under section 324(3).
- (3A) A regulation further extending the period of a declared public health emergency—
  - (a) must state the period, of not more than 7 days, by which the declared public health emergency is further extended; and
  - (b) expires at the end of the stated period unless the regulation is sooner repealed or it expires under section 324(3).
- (2) Section 323(3A) and (4)—
