1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the Youth Justice and Other Legislation (Inclusion of 17-year-old Persons) Amendment (Postponement) Regulation 2017.

2 Postponed commencement of uncommenced provisions

- (1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 11 February 2018.
- (2) In this section—

postponed law means the uncommenced provisions of the Youth Justice and Other Legislation (Inclusion of 17-year-old Persons) Amendment Act 2016.

Editor's note—

The postponed law now automatically commences on 12 February 2018.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 13 February 2018.
