## 1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Youth Justice and Other Legislation (Inclusion of 17-year-old Persons) Amendment (Postponement) Regulation 2017*.

## 2 Postponed commencement of uncommenced provisions

(1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 11 February 2018.

(2) In this section—

*postponed law* means the uncommenced provisions of the *Youth Justice and Other Legislation (Inclusion of 17-year-old Persons) Amendment Act 2016*.

*Editor's note—*

The postponed law now automatically commences on 12 February 2018.

## 3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 13 February 2018.
