1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Trusts Regulation 2026*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 28 April 2026.

3 Fee for application to Attorney-General for approval of scheme—Act, s 202

For section 202(3)(c) of the Act, the following fees are prescribed—

- (a) if the trustee is a corporation or, if there is more than 1 trustee, at least 1 of the trustees is a corporation—\$1,750;
- (b) otherwise—
 - (i) if the value of all the trust property is not more than \$500,000—\$500; or
 - (ii) if the value of all the trust property is more than \$500,000—\$750.
