Acquisition of Land Regulation 2003

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the Acquisition of Land Regulation 2003.

2 Fee—Act, s 9

The fee payable for an application under section 9 of the Act is—

- (a) if the application relates to only 1 parcel of land—\$162.30; or
- (b) if the application relates to more than 1 parcel of land—\$162.30 plus \$48.15 for each additional parcel of land.

3 Repeal

The Acquisition of Land Regulation 1993 is repealed.
