Criminal Code (Government Agencies) Regulation 2026

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Criminal Code (Government Agencies) Regulation 2026*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day the *Penalties and Sentences (Sexual Offences) and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2025*, section 10 commences.

3 Government agencies

For the Criminal Code, section 97A(3), definition *government agency*, paragraph (b), each of the following entities is prescribed to be a government agency—

- (a) the Crime and Corruption Commission;
- (b) Legal Aid Queensland established under the *Legal Aid Queensland Act 1997*;
- (c) a local government;
- (d) the Office of the Ombudsman established under the *Ombudsman Act 2001*;
- (e) the Parole Board Queensland established under the *Corrective Services Act 2006*;
- (f) the Queensland Audit Office established under the *Auditor-General Act 2009*;
- (g) the Supreme Court Library Committee established under the *Supreme Court Library Act 1968*.
