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Police Superannuation Regulation 1970

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POLICE SUPERANNUATION REGULATION 1970

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 4 June 1996]

Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Regulation 1970*.

Definition

2. In this regulation—

“**approved form**” see section 13.

Members of Queensland Police Service who are not members of the police force for the Act

3. A member of the Queensland Police Service is not a member of the police force for the purposes of the Act if the person—

- (a) is appointed under the *Police Service Administration Act 1990* as a staff member, police recruit or special constable; and
- (b) was not a member of the police force for the purposes of the Act immediately before the appointment.

The conduct of the business of the board

4.(1) The board shall meet in the second and fourth weeks of each month for any business unless the board has previously determined that it shall not meet in any of these weeks.

(2) Such determinations by the board may be made from time to time.

(3) The day, hour and place of every meeting of the board shall be as previously determined by the board, or, in default or in the case of a special

meeting convened upon requisition as referred to in section 5 as the manager may appoint.

Special meetings of board

5.(1) The manager shall on requisition, in accordance with this section, of any 2 members of the board convene a special meeting of the board.

(2) The requisition shall be in writing, state the objects of the meeting, and be signed by the requisitionists, and shall be deposited with the manager.

(3) Notice of the special meeting shall specify the objects of the meeting as stated in the requisition.

Notice of board meetings

6. Where the time and place of any meeting of the board is appointed by the manager and in every other case where notice of a meeting is given, notice of the meeting shall be given by the manager to each member of the board at least 3 days before the meeting.

Failure to give notice does not invalidate proceedings

7. The accidental omission to give notice of any meeting to, or the non-receipt of notice of any meeting by, any member shall not invalidate the proceedings at the meeting (including any adjournment thereof).

Conduct of board business

8.(1) The board shall commence business at the hour appointed for holding the meeting, or so soon thereafter as a sufficient number of members is present to form a quorum.

(2) If at the expiration of 15 minutes after the hour appointed for the holding of the meeting a quorum is not present, the meeting shall not proceed on that day but stand adjourned to such day, hour, and place as may be fixed by the members present, or, in default, by the manager, and the circumstances, together with the names of the members then present shall be recorded in the minute book.

Adjournment of board meetings

9.(1) The board may adjourn a meeting from time to time and from place to place, but no business shall be transacted at any adjourned meeting other than the business left unfinished at the meeting from which the adjournment took place.

(2) Without prejudice to anything in this regulation contained, it shall not be necessary to give any notice of an adjournment or of the business to be transacted at an adjourned meeting.

Confidentiality of board business

10. All deliberations and business of the board shall be strictly confidential, and any particulars relating thereto shall not be communicated to any person, but the board may—

- (a) consent to the communication to any person of any such particulars;
- (b) authorise the manager to publish a report of all or any part of the proceedings;

as it thinks fit.

Calculation of benefits

11. In order to ascertain the fortnightly equivalent of the annual amount of benefits payable, the following formula shall apply—

divide the amount of the total annual benefit by 26.09, and the amount so obtained shall be taken to the next higher cent.

Proof of incapacity

12. Any member retired from the police force by reason of incapacity is to furnish to the board the following notifications and certificates whilst he or she is in receipt of incapacity benefit—

- (a) a statement at the end of each calendar month indicating whether or not he or she engaged in any work during the month;
- (b) a statement at the end of each financial year giving details of any

work engaged in during the previous 12 months;

- (c) a medical report from a government medical officer or other medical practitioner approved by the board after the end of each financial year.

Proof of entitlement to benefits

13. The manager of the board may from time to time require evidence that payments from the police superannuation fund are being properly made and for this purpose may require any person in receipt of benefits from the police superannuation fund to supply information in the approved form.

Approval of forms

14. The chief executive may approve forms for use under the Act.

Approved forms

14.(1) *This section applies if—*

- (a) *immediately before its commencement, there was a prescribed form for a matter; and*
- (b) *on its commencement, there is to be an approved form for the matter or a form may be approved for the matter.*

(2) *Until there is an approved form for the matter, the form that was the prescribed form for the matter immediately before the commencement is taken to be the approved form for the matter.*

(3) *This section expires 3 months after it commences.¹*
