HEALTH SERVICES (TRANSFER OF OFFICERS) REGULATION 1992

Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Health Services (Transfer of Officers) Regulation 1992*³.

Definitions

2. In this regulation—

“**order in council**” means the *Department of Health (Transfer of Officers) Order (No. 1) 1992*;

“**transferred officer**” means an officer mentioned in the Schedule.

End of secondment

3. The day fixed under section 5(2) of the order in council, for the termination of the period of secondment, is the day this regulation commences.

Transfer of officers

4. Each officer mentioned in the Schedule is transferred from the Department of Health to the relevant Authority.

Transitional

5.(1) Each transferred officer retains—

- (a) the salary and conditions of employment; and
- (b) the entitlements with respect to leave and superannuation;

that applied to the officer before the commencement of this regulation.

(2) To remove any doubt, the service of a transferred officer is not to be taken as non-continuous for the purposes of a matter mentioned in subsection (1) merely because of the transfer effected under this regulation.

Repeal

6. The order in council in repealed at the end of the day this regulation commences.
