## **PAWNBROKERS REGULATION 1994**

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 1 July 2003]

### **1 Short title**

This regulation may be cited as the *Pawnbrokers Regulation 1994*.

### **4 Fees**

The fees payable under the Act are set out in the schedule.

### **5 Licence must be signed**

Immediately after a person receives a licence issued to him or her, the person must sign the licence, in ink, in the space provided.

Maximum penalty—8 penalty units.

### **6 Register of licences**

(1) The chief executive must keep a register containing the current details of each licence issued.

(2) A person may inspect the register on payment of the relevant fee set out in the schedule.
