PART 1—PRELIMINARY

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Meat Industry Regulation 1994*.

2 Animals to which Act does not apply—Act, s 7(3)

Animals other than warm blooded vertebrates and reptiles are declared to be animals to which the Act does not apply.

3 Prohibited animals—Act, s 54(2)

A prohibited animal is of the species—

- (a) canine; or
- (b) feline.

4 Standards approved

The following standards are approved—

- (a) the *Meat Industry Standard 1994*;
- (b) the *Meat Industry (Construction of Premises Processing Animals for Human Consumption) Standard 1996*;
- (c) the *Meat Industry (Construction of Premises Processing Meat for Human Consumption) Standard 1996*;

- (d) the *Meat Industry (Hygienic Production of Meat for Human Consumption) Standard 1996*;
