PHARMACY REGULATION 1997

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 1 February 2002]

Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Pharmacy Regulation 1997*.

Prescribed qualifications—Act, s 19(1)(a)

2. For section 19(1)(a) of the Act, the prescribed qualifications for registration as a pharmacist are the qualifications stated in the schedule.
