STATE COUNTER-DISASTER ORGANISATION REGULATION 1998

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *State Counter-Disaster Organisation Regulation 1998*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 18 September 1998.

3 Central control group member to preside in absence of chairperson—Act, s 12

For section 12(3)¹ of the Act, the chief executive is the member to preside at all meetings and consultations among members of the central control group in the chairperson's absence.

4 Other members of disaster district control groups—Act, s 21

For section 21(1) of the Act, the members (other than the disaster district coordinator)² for each disaster district control group are as follows—

(a) if—

- (i) there is 1 local government only in the disaster district—a person appointed by the local government; or
- (ii) there are 2 or more local governments in the disaster district and none of the local governments combine for counterdisaster purposes under section 26³ of the Act—a person appointed by each local government; or

1 Section 12 (Central control group)

2 The disaster district coordinator is appointed by the Governor in Council under section 21(1) of the Act.

3 Section 26 (Duties as to counterdisaster measures)

- (iii) there are 2 or more local governments in the disaster district and all the local governments combine for counterdisaster purposes under section 26 of the Act—a person appointed by each combined local government; or
- (iv) there are 3 or more local governments in the disaster district and not all the local governments combine for counterdisaster purposes under section 26 of the Act—
 - (A) a person appointed by each local government that does not combine; and
 - (B) a person appointed by each combined local government;
- (b) a person appointed by the Minister responsible for the *Ambulance Service Act 1991*;
- (c) a person appointed by the Minister responsible for the *Family Services Act 1987*;
- (d) a person appointed by the Minister responsible for the *Fire and Rescue Authority Act 1990*;
- (e) a person appointed by the Minister responsible for the *Health Act 1937*;
- (f) a person appointed by the Minister responsible for the *Police Service Administration Act 1990*;
- (g) a person who has experience in building engineering services and is appointed by the Minister responsible for the *Queensland Building Services Act 1991*;
- (h) a person who has experience in electronic communication services and is appointed by the Minister responsible for the *Queensland Building Services Act 1991*;
- (i) a person who has experience in supplying emergency goods and services and is appointed by the Minister responsible for the *Queensland Building Services Act 1991*;
- (j) a person appointed by the Minister responsible for the *State Counter-Disaster Organisation Act 1975*;
- (k) a person appointed by the Minister responsible for the *Transport Infrastructure Act 1994*.

5 Repeal

The *State Counter-Disaster Organization Regulation 1975* is repealed.
