# GOVERNMENT OWNED CORPORATIONS (TAB CORPORATISATION) REGULATION 1999

[reprinted as in force on 20 July 1999]

## PART 1—PRELIMINARY

### 1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Government Owned Corporations (TAB Corporatisation) Regulation 1999*.

### 2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day the *Racing Legislation Amendment Act 1998*, section 36 commences.

### 3 Purpose

The purpose of this regulation is—

- (a) to change the name of the Totalisator Board; and
- (b) to declare that TAB is a GOC (a statutory GOC); and
- (c) to provide for the functions of TAB (as a statutory GOC); and
- (d) to nominate TAB as a candidate GOC that is to become a company GOC; and
- (e) to declare that TAB is a GOC (a company GOC).

### 4 Definitions

In this regulation—

“**TAB**” means TAB Queensland.

“**Totalisator Board**” means the Totalisator Administration Board of Queensland.

## **PART 2—PREPARATORY MATTERS**

### **5 Change of name of Totalisator Board**

Totalisator Board's name is changed to TAB Queensland.

### **6 Share capital**

On the commencement of this section, TAB is taken to have a share capital of \$1 000 000 000 made up of 4 voting (A class) shares of \$1 each and 999 999 996 non-voting (B class) shares of \$1 each.

## **PART 3—TAB BECOMES A STATUTORY GOC**

### **7 Declaration of TAB as a GOC**

(1) Subsection (2) takes effect as soon as TAB has applied the part of its share capital that its responsible Ministers direct in paying up, in full, shares in itself.

(2) TAB is a GOC.

## **PART 4—FUNCTIONS OF TAB**

### **8 When part takes effect**

This part takes effect when TAB becomes a GOC under section 7(2).

### **9 TAB's functions**

(1) TAB's primary function is to conduct gambling activities (whether in Queensland or elsewhere).

(2) TAB also has the function of carrying on any activity relating or helpful to its primary function.

(3) Subsections (1) and (2) cease to apply to TAB when TAB becomes a company GOC.

(4) In this section—

“**gambling activities**” include activities authorised or permitted to be carried on under—

- (a) an operator’s licence under part 3A of the *Gaming Machine Act 1991*; or
- (b) an interactive gambling licence under the *Interactive Gambling (Player Protection) Act 1998*; or
- (c) a keno licence under the *Keno Act 1996*; or
- (d) a race or sports wagering licence under the *Wagering Act 1998*.

## **PART 5—NOMINATION OF TAB AS CANDIDATE GOC THAT IS TO BECOME A COMPANY GOC**

### **10 Nomination of TAB**

(1) Subsection (2) takes effect immediately after TAB becomes a GOC under part 3.

(2) TAB is nominated to be a candidate GOC that is to become a company GOC.

## **PART 6—TAB BECOMES A COMPANY GOC**

### **11 Declaration of TAB as a GOC**

(1) Subsection (2) takes effect as soon as both of the following apply—

- (a) TAB is a candidate GOC that is to become a company GOC;
- (b) TAB is a public company, and a company limited by shares, within the meaning of the Corporations Law.

(2) TAB is a GOC.

(3) As soon as practicable after TAB becomes a company GOC under subsection (2), the shareholding Ministers for the company GOC that TAB has become must, by gazette notice, advise the day on which the entity became registered under the Corporations Law, chapter 5B, part 5B.1, division 1.<sup>1</sup>
