1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Local Government (Aboriginal Lands) Regulation 2001*.

2 Reservation of parts of Shire of Aurukun—Act, s 3(4) and (6)

- (1) The land within the Shire of Aurukun, mentioned in schedule 1, column 1, is reserved and set apart as a reserve for the purposes stated opposite in column 2.

A plan mentioned in this regulation may be inspected during business hours at the department's head office in Brisbane.

- (2) The person mentioned opposite the land in column 3 is appointed as trustee for the reserve.
