Fair Trading (Novelty Dummy) Order 2004

1 Short title

This order may be cited as the *Fair Trading (Novelty Dummy) Order 2004*.

2 Supply of novelty dummy prohibited

- (1) The supply of a novelty dummy, or goods substantially the same as a novelty dummy, is prohibited under section 85¹ of the Act.

Note—

Section 85(5) of the Act provides that this order expires 18 months after the order commences, and may not be renewed.

- (2) In this section—

baby's dummy means an article—

- (a) that includes a teat that a baby sucks but from which the baby does not obtain fluid; and
- (b) that may be used to calm a baby.

novelty dummy means an article that—

- (a) resembles a baby's dummy in appearance and size; and
- (b) includes electronic components; and
- (c) does not comply with the requirements of AS 2432–1991, clauses 6, 7 and 8(c).²

1 See section 85 (Minister may make orders prohibiting or restricting supply of dangerous or undesirable goods or services) of the Act.

2 AS 2432–1991 (Babies' dummies), clauses 6 (Design and construction), 7 (Performance test requirements) and 8 (Packaging)
