1 Short title

This notice may be cited as the *Plant Protection (Mango Leafhopper Quarantine) Notice 2005*.¹

2 Definitions

In this notice—

mango leafhopper means any pest described in the *Plant Protection Regulation 2002*, schedule 1, part 1, opposite the common name ‘mango leafhopper’.

pest quarantine area means the pest quarantine area declared under section 3.

3 Declaration of pest quarantine area

The area of the Shire of Mareeba is declared to be a pest quarantine area for mango leafhopper.

4 Objects of quarantine

The objects of the quarantine for the pest quarantine area are—

- (a) to prevent the spread of mango leafhopper in the pest quarantine area; and

1 This notice remains in force until whichever of the following first happens—

- (a) the commencement of a replacement regulation;
- (b) the end of 3 months.

See section 11(9) of the Act.

- (b) to prevent mango leafhopper being brought out of the pest quarantine area.

5 Restrictions on movement

- (1) A person must not, without an inspector's approval, move a mango leafhopper or mango plant—
 - (a) from a parcel of land in the pest quarantine area to another parcel of land in the area; or
 - (b) out of the pest quarantine area.
- (2) An inspector may give an approval only if the inspector is satisfied the movement of the mango leafhopper or mango plant will not pose a significant risk of—
 - (a) spreading mango leafhopper in the pest quarantine area;
or
 - (b) bringing mango leafhopper out of the pest quarantine area.
- (3) In this section—

mango plant means a plant of the genus *Mangifera* spp., other than the fruit of the plant and any stems attached to the fruit.
