1 Short title

This notice may be cited as the *Plant Protection (Tomato Yellow Leaf Curl Virus) Notice 2006*.

Note—

Under section 4(3) of the Act, this notice remains in force until whichever of the following first happens—

- (a) the commencement of a regulation prescribing the *tomato yellow leaf curl virus* to be a pest for the purposes of the Act;
- (b) the end of 3 months.

2 Pest declaration—Act, s 4(2)

Tomato yellow leaf curl virus is declared to be a pest for the Act.
