Health Practitioners (Special Events Exemption) Regulation 2009

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 13 November 2014]

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Health Practitioners (Special Events Exemption) Regulation 2009*.

2 Declaration of G20 meeting as special event

- (1) The G20 meeting is declared to be a special event for the Act.
- (2) The exemption under the Act for the event has effect for the period starting on 18 September 2014 and ending on 17 November 2014.
- (3) In this section—
G20 meeting see the *G20 (Safety and Security) Act 2013*, schedule 7.

3 Declaration of AFC Asian Cup 2015 as special event

- (1) The event known as ‘AFC Asian Cup 2015’ is declared to be a special event for the Act.
- (2) The exemption under the Act for the event has effect for the period starting on 9 December 2014 and ending on 8 February 2015.

4 Declaration of ICC Cricket World Cup 2015 as special event

- (1) The event known as ‘ICC Cricket World Cup 2015’ is declared to be a special event for the Act.

- (2) The exemption under the Act for the event has effect for the period starting on 14 January 2015 and ending on 5 April 2015.
