Spelling

City of Brisbane (Transitional) Regulation 2010

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 1 July 2010]

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *City of Brisbane (Transitional) Regulation 2010*.

2 Commencement

This regulation is taken to have commenced on 1 July 2010.

See section 264(2) of the Act.

3 Preparation of annual report and financial statements for 2009–2010 financial year

Despite the repeal of the *City of Brisbane Act 1924*, the following provisions continue to apply to the council for preparing its annual report and financial statements under that Act for the financial year that ended on 30 June 2010—

- (a) part 4, division 4 of that Act;
- (b) the repealed *City of Brisbane Regulation 2004*, sections 6, 17, 23, 33 and 34.

3A Transitional provisions for by-elections

- (1) Despite the repeal of the *City of Brisbane Act 1924*, the election provisions of that Act continue to apply to by-elections for the council—
 - (a) as if a reference in the provisions to the town clerk were a reference to the chief executive officer; and
 - (b) with other necessary changes.

[s 4]

- (2) The *election provisions*, of the repealed City of Brisbane Act, are—
 - (a) part 2, divisions 3 and 5; and
 - (b) any provisions of schedule 2 that are relevant to the provisions mentioned in paragraph (a).
- (3) Despite the repeal of the *Local Government Act 1993*, the provisions of that Act in force on 30 June 2010 as they applied to the Brisbane City Council on that day continue to apply to by-elections for the council—
 - (a) as if a reference in the provisions to a division of a local government area were a reference to a ward; and
 - (b) as if a reference in the provisions to a local government Act were taken to include a reference to this Act; and
 - (c) with other necessary changes.

4 Declaration that regulation is a transitional regulation

This regulation is a transitional regulation.

Note—

This regulation expires 1 year after the commencement of section 264 of the Act. See section 264(4) of the Act.
