1 Short title

This notice may be cited as the *Exotic Diseases in Animals (Avian Paramyxovirus) Notice 2011*.

2 Commencement

3 Definitions

In this notice—

exotic disease means avian paramyxovirus.

restricted area means the restricted area described in section 4.

Queensland is a restricted area for the exotic disease.

5 Declaration—Act, s 10A

The movement of any of the following from New South Wales or Victoria into the restricted area is restricted—

- (a) a pigeon;
- (b) a pigeon egg;
- (c) a fitting used with pigeons.
